
REPORTS AND COMMENTS:

- **Police.**
 - Chief Lauer updated the Board on recently issued tickets.
 - There was a brief discussion of outstanding vehicle abatements. Mr. Borghardt made a motion to allow 30 days to complete. Ms. Lenger seconded. The motion passed unanimously.
- **Water and Sewer.** The Board discussed the various proposed solutions for sealing the lift station. Ms. Fontana will contact Walters Construction regarding their original proposal.
- **Attorney.** Ms. Force had provided an update that tickets had been filed and court day is scheduled for July 22.
- **Clerk.** Ms. Lenger made a motion to accept the monthly financial report. Mr. Weber seconded. The motion passed unanimously.
- **Board Members.** Mr. Borghardt expressed concern over street lights and poorly lit areas. A map of current lighting will be provided at the next meeting.
- **Mayor.**
 - Mr. Lachner stated property owners were making progress in cleaning up unlicensed vehicles.
 - Mr. Lachner trimmed weeds at the lagoon.
